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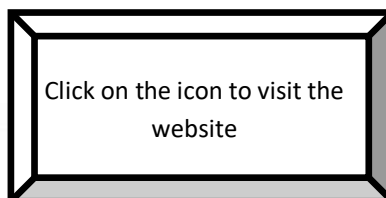

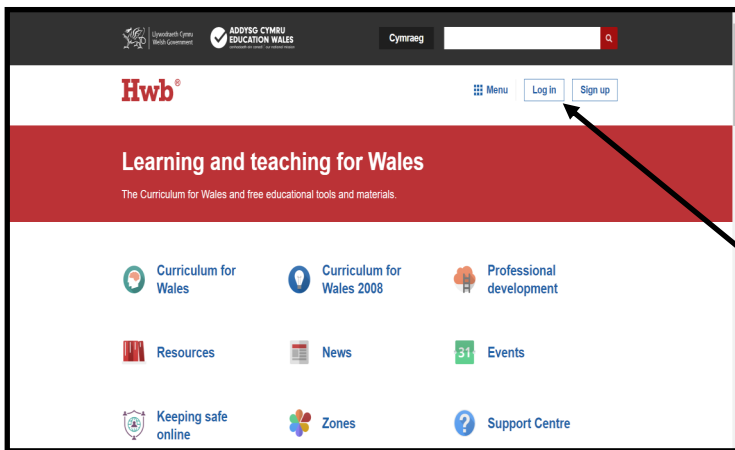

Signing onto HWB

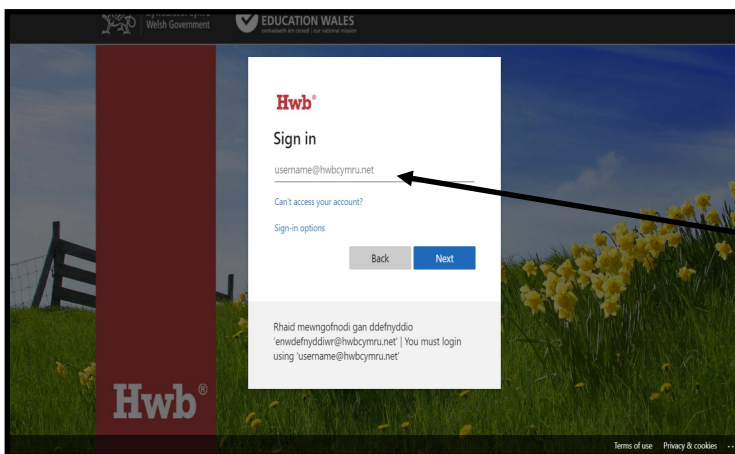


Sign into HWB from your tablet or laptop to be able to access Google Classroom.

Enter address

www.hwb.gov.wales

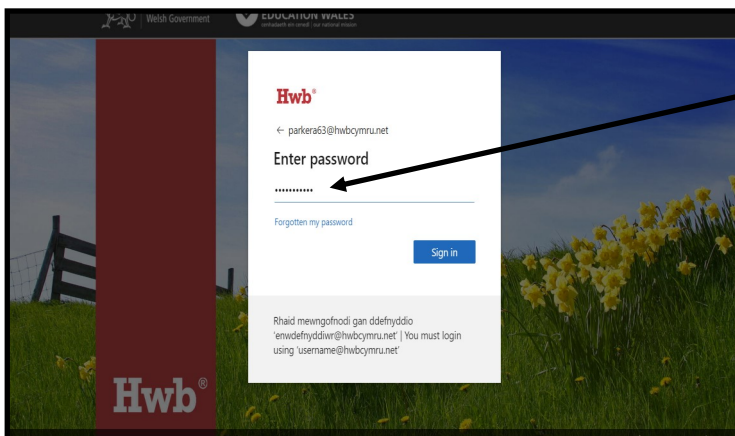
Click on the 'log in' button.



Your teachers should have provided children with the HWB login as well as their Active Learn and Giglets.

Make sure you type the full address including @hwbcmru.net

Usernames include surname, first initial and possibly a number. This is not case sensitive.



Now type the password.

Take care with this. Every password contains a 4 letter word and 4 numbers. The first letter of the word is a capital.

Example: Fish3333

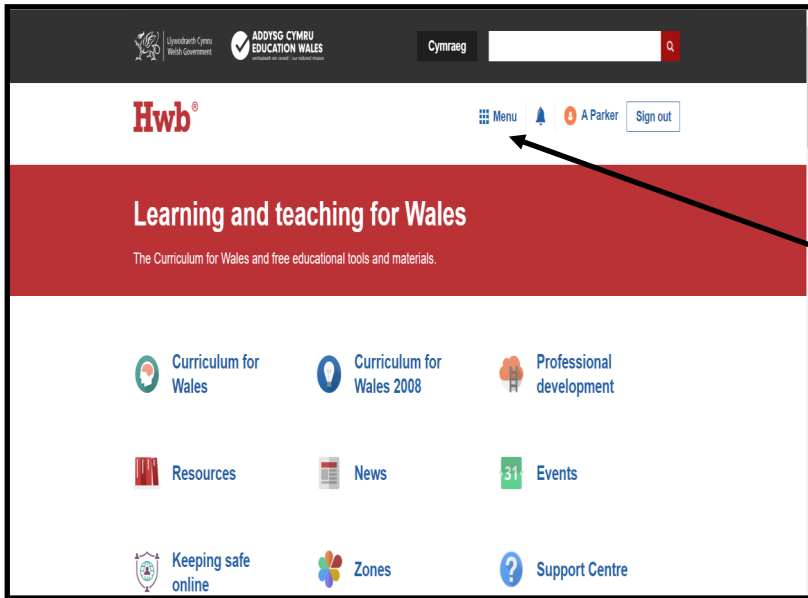
If using a Chromebook use the shift key and the keyboard letter at the same time.



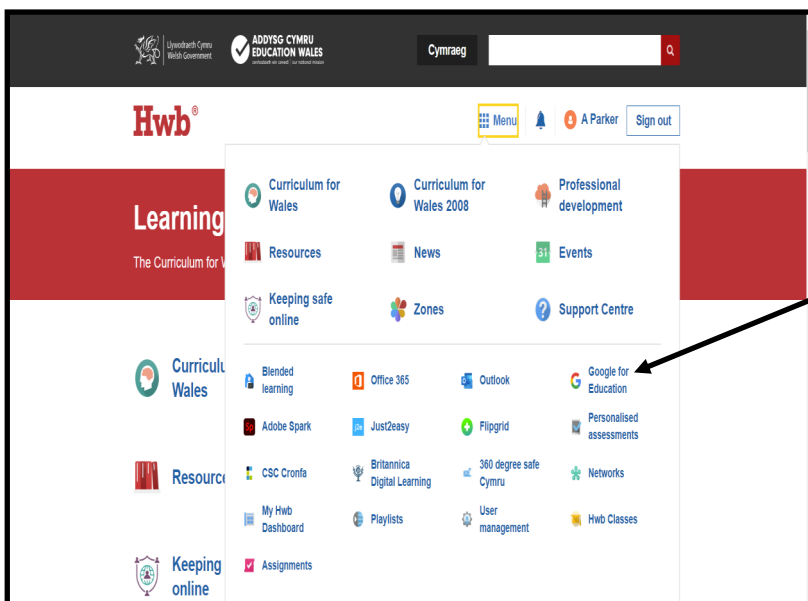
When you are logged in you will see your name appear.



Signing into Google Classroom

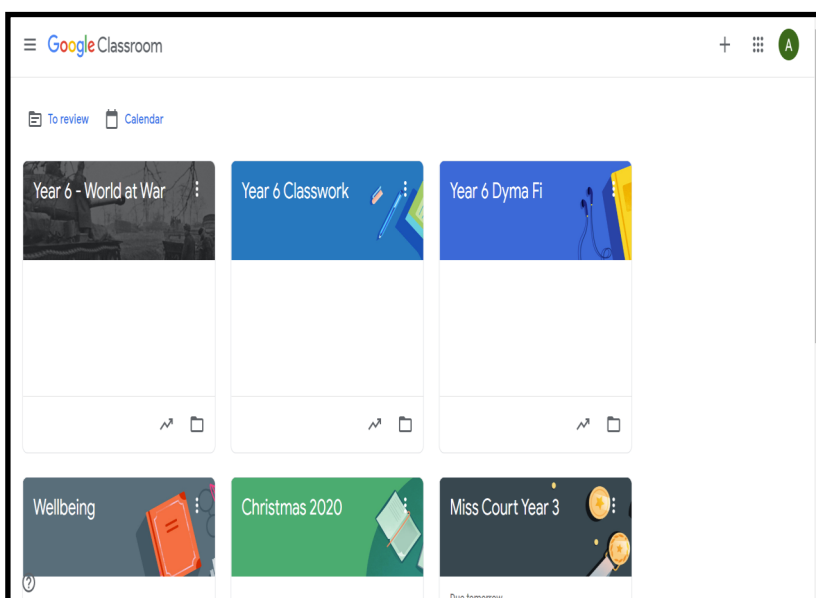


Once you are logged in click on the menu button.



Choose Google for Education

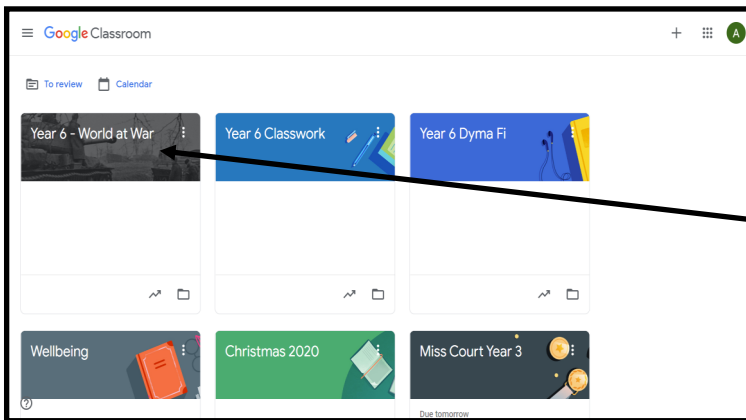
You may have to sign in again. Put in the whole username including @hwbcymru.net



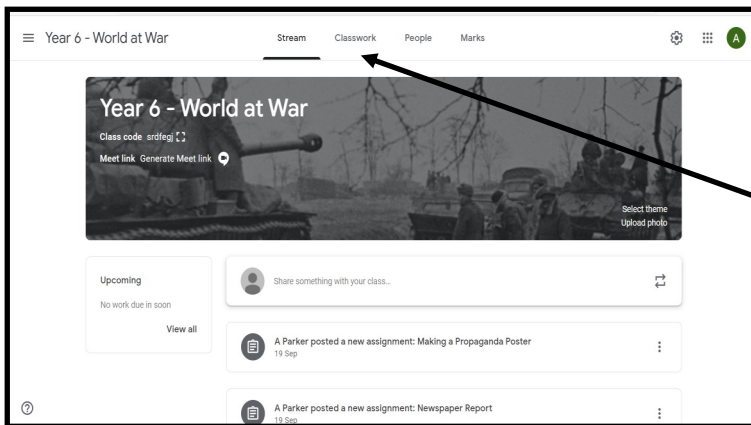
Your teacher would have set up a classroom in the event of closure and all of the work will be found in here.



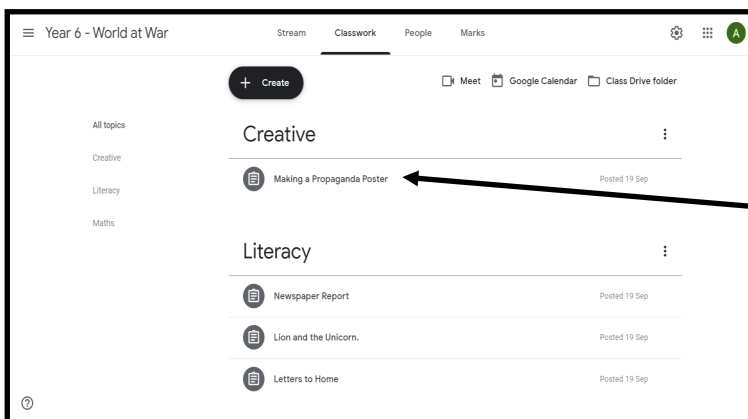
Accessing Work at Home



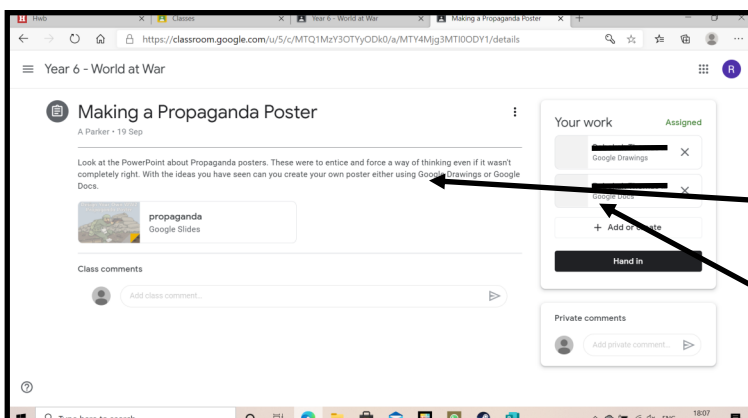
Choose the name of the classroom that will involve the work for your children.



The easiest way to find the work is to click on the 'classwork' tab



Now, choose the activity you wish to complete.



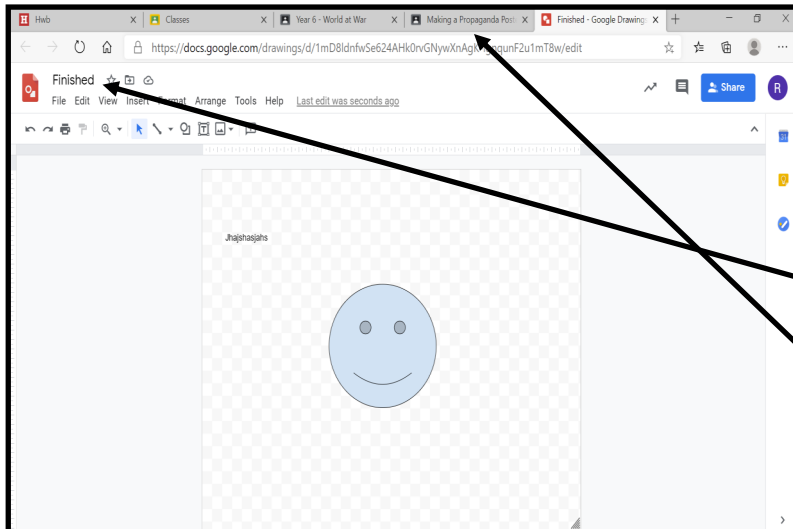
Here you will find all the information your child will need to complete this task.

The explanation will say what the teacher wants the child to do as well as any PowerPoints or links that will help teach the skill..

The document they are to work on.



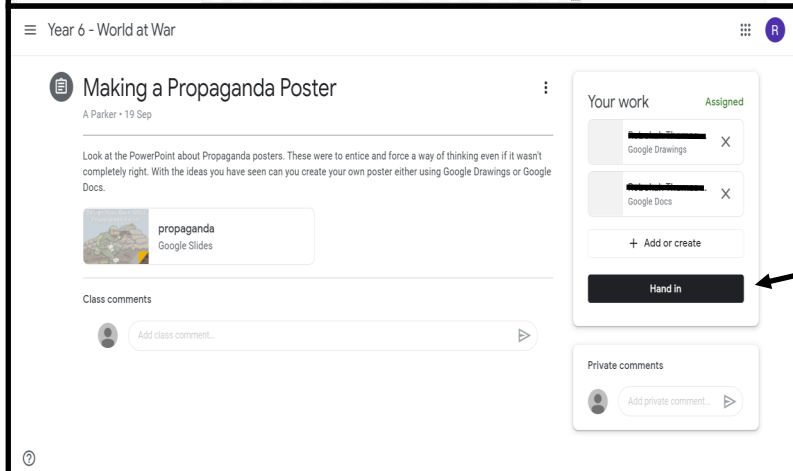
Handing in Work



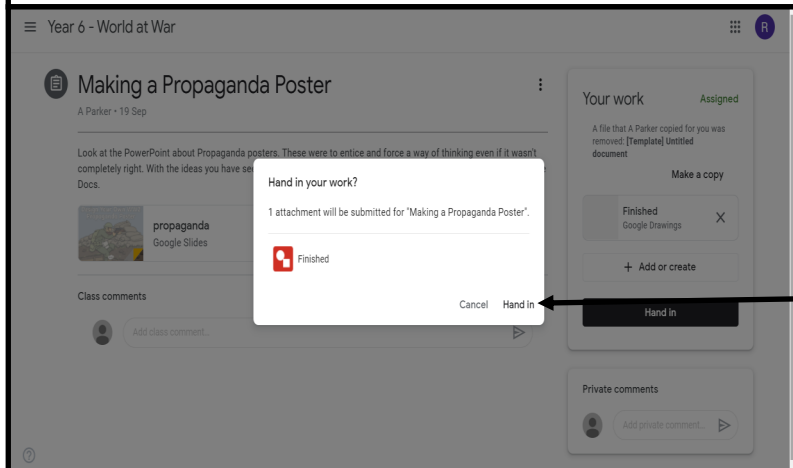
Once the work is complete Google will save the work automatically.

Change the title of the piece.

Return to the tab that had the assignment on.

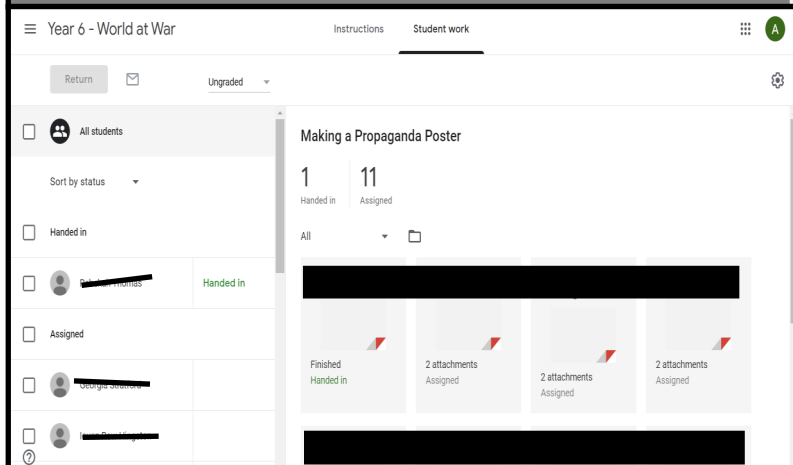


Press the 'Hand In' button



This will ask you to confirm that you wish to submit the work.

Choose 'Hand In'




Your teacher will then see that the work has been handed in and they can mark it and return.

Look back to see if your teacher has sent a question for your child to answer about the work.



Signing onto Giglets



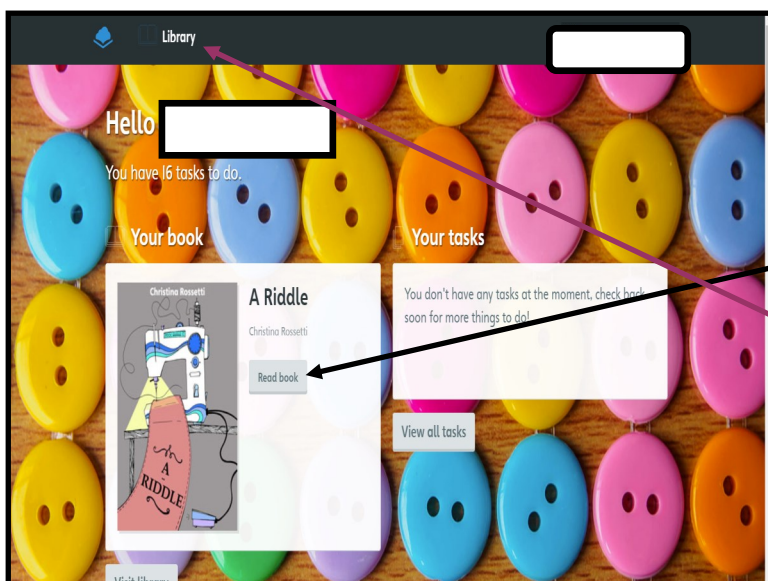

School Code: Greenway

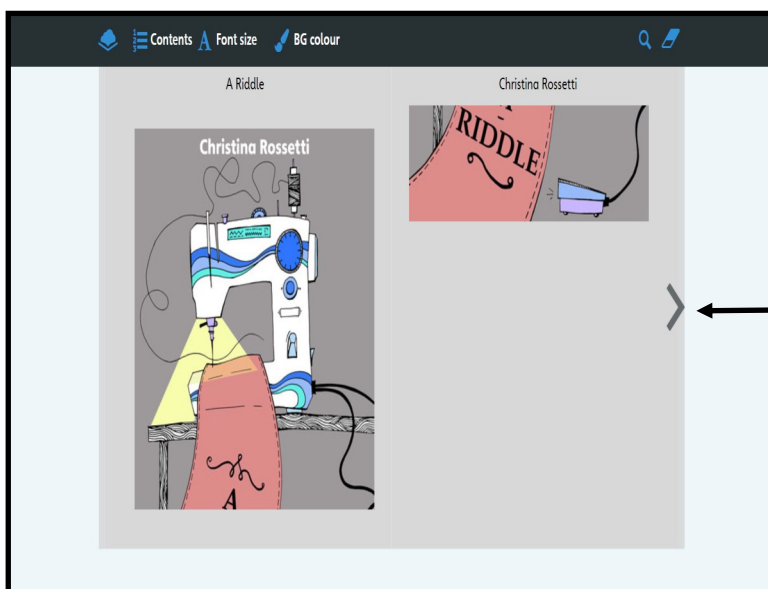
Username: Same as HWB but without @hwbcymru.net

To access your book choose 'Read Book'

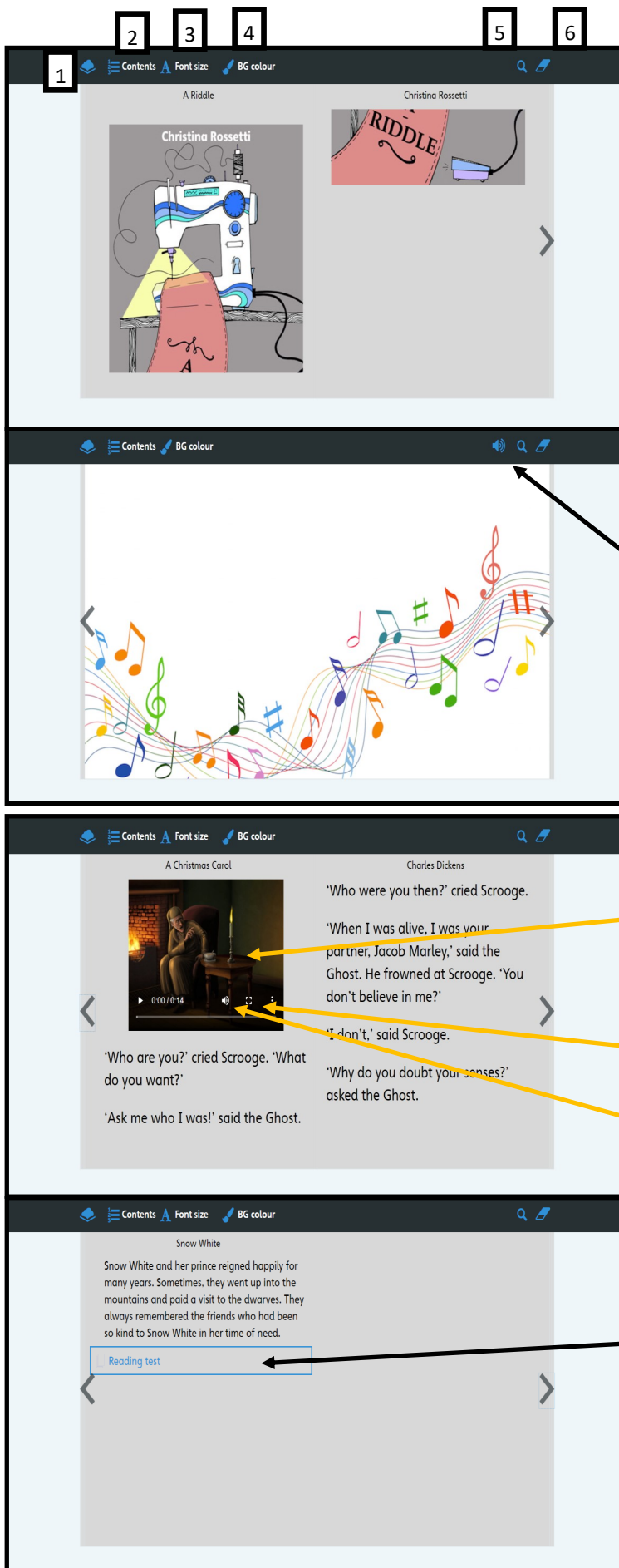
If you wish to look at other books assigned and change select library.



You are now accessing the books. Click on the arrow to change the page.



Features of Giglets



- 1) Returns you to main menu.
- 2) Allows you to jump to different sections of the story. Ideal if the text is long.
- 3) Allows you to change the size of the font. Keep pressing to return to first selection,
- 4) Changes the colour of the pages.
- 5) Search for certain words
- 6) Allows you to highlight words or phrases. Good for when you have a question.

A lot of the books begin with a page like this. It means there is music that can be played that will sense the mood of the story.

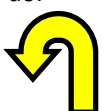
Some stories have videos that recreate part of the text. These are only short but create a sense of what is going on.

To expand the video click this button.


If there is no sound make sure the sound is enabled here

Your teacher may include some questions which relate to the text. This will appear like this but may also include a small question mark which can be tricky to see.

The books to be read will appear on Google Classroom as well as any tasks your teacher wishes you to do.

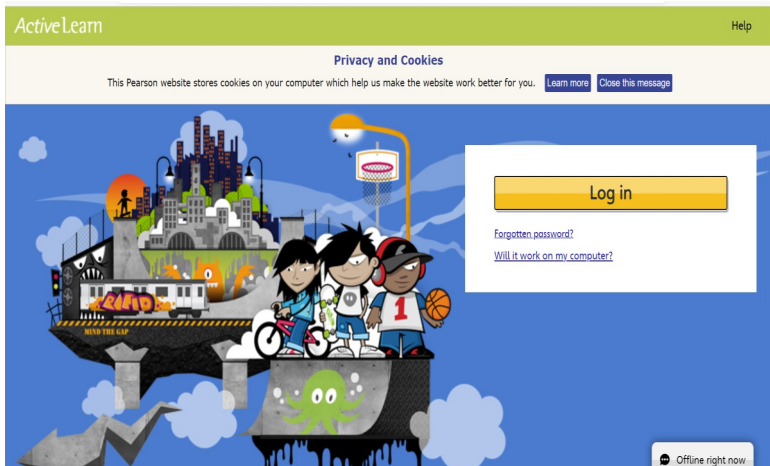

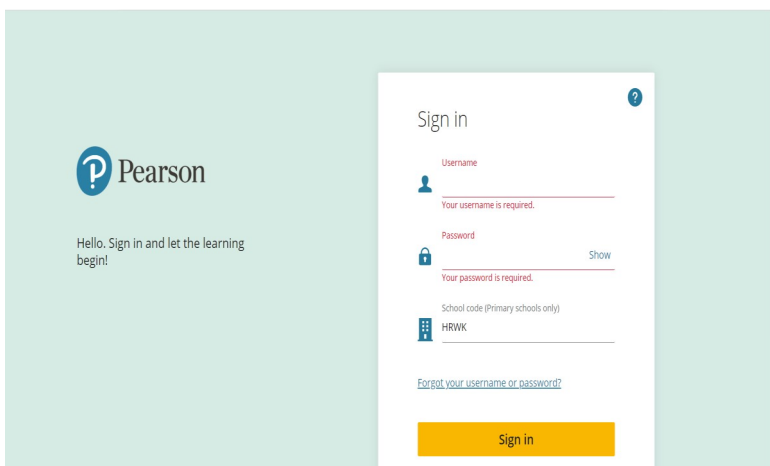

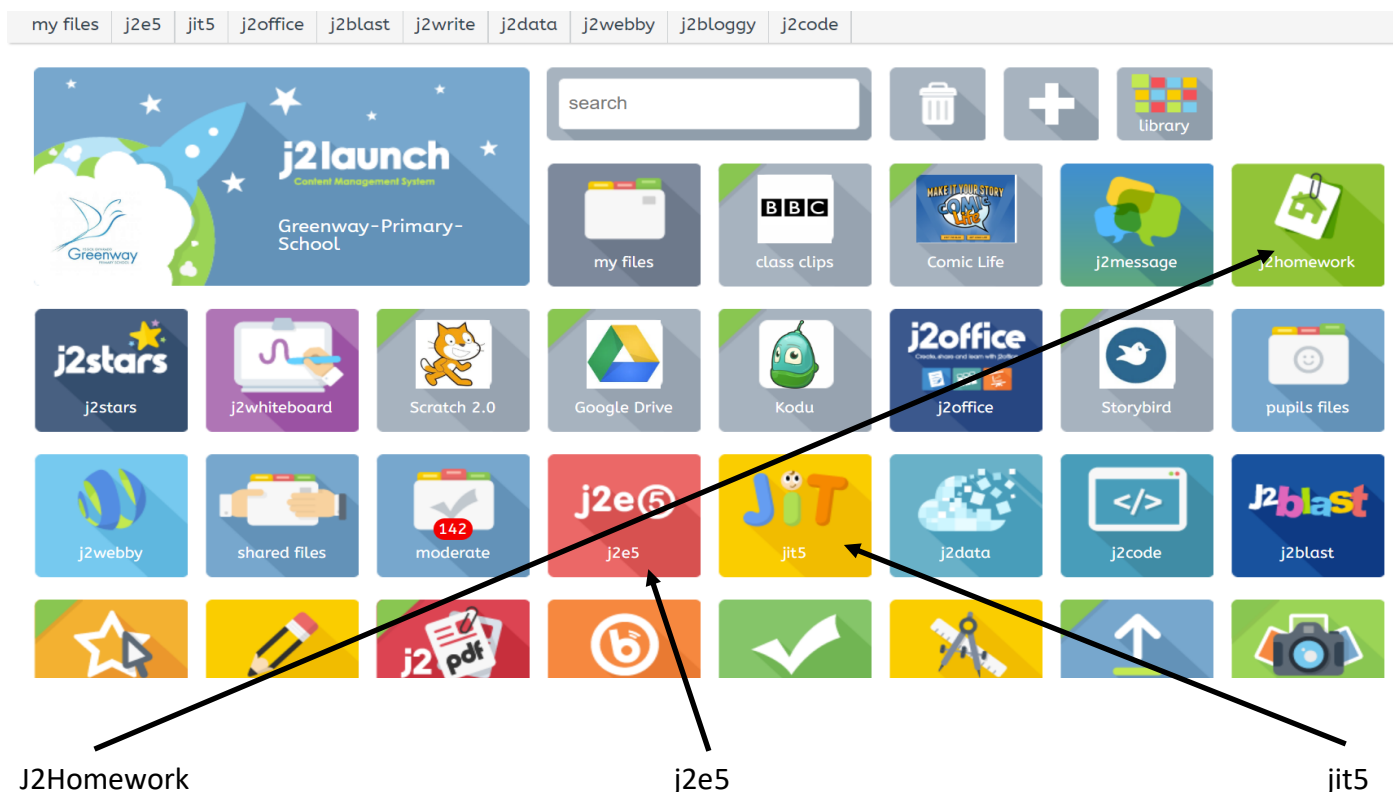

J2E



Apps

J2E has a number of apps that you can see on your dashboard which is the screen you can see above. At home you may be asked to use a couple of apps that will help you learn. The tasks will be set in Google Classroom and ask you to access J2E through HWB.

J2Homework

On here the class teacher may include details of a task to do. These will be similar to the task set on Google Classroom and save you from jumping between programmes.

J2E5

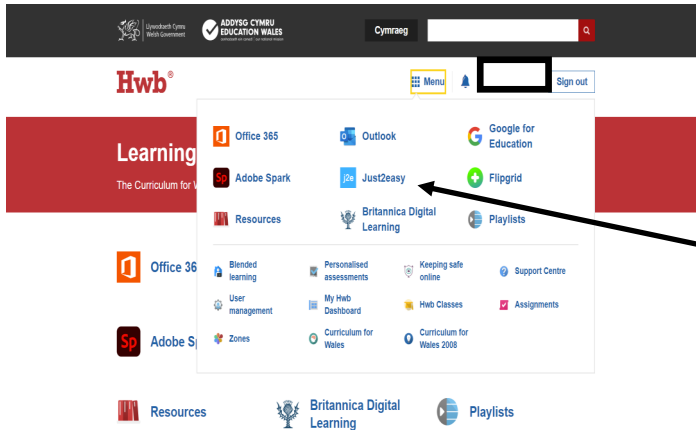
For older children this is a word processing programme that will allow them to write some work or to create a poster. The features are safe and linked with HWB. The children will be used to using this from their time in class.

JIT5

This is ideal for younger children. It features a number of tools that are easier for younger learners. Includes a simple paint tool, PowerPoint and other useful tools. Children would have used this in class if the task on Google Classroom directs you that way.

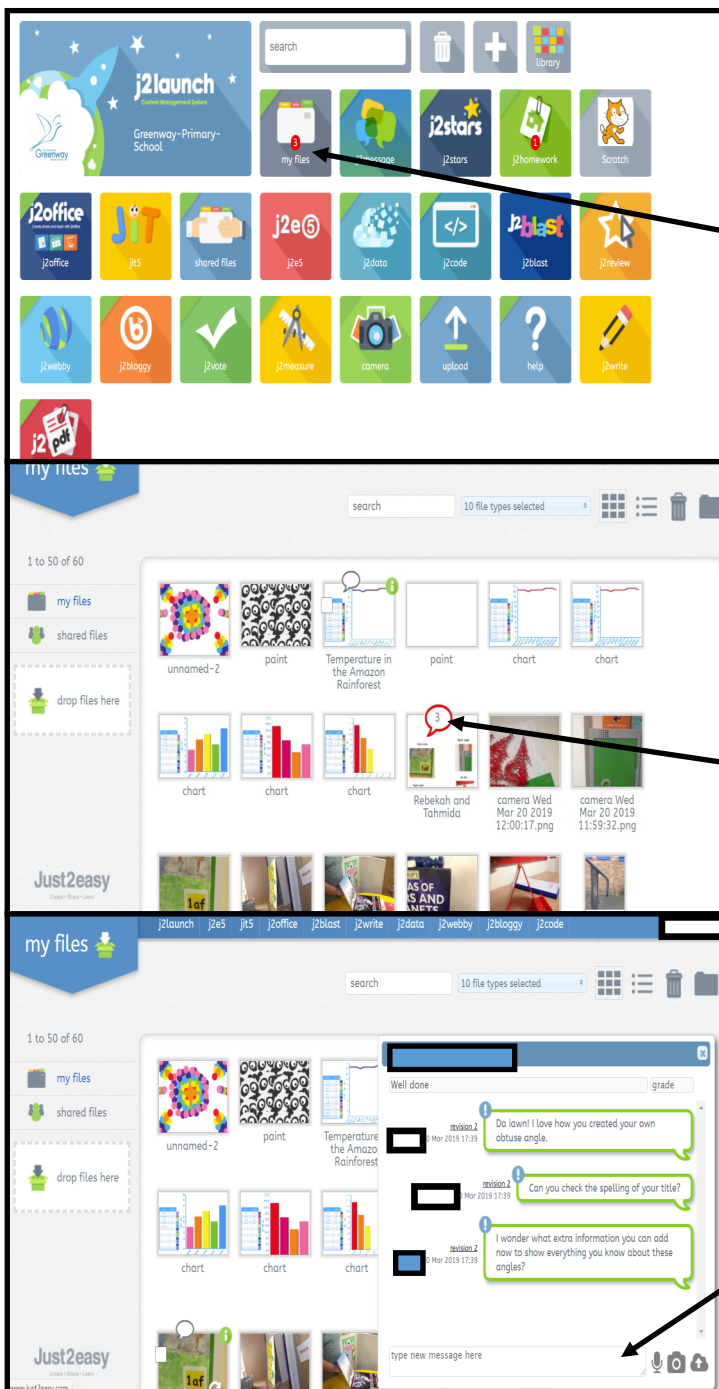


Accessing Just 2 Easy



To access Just2Easy login to Hwb as you saw earlier in the guide. Click on the waffle/menu and click on Just2Easy. You will not have to put in your login details again.

Finding Teacher Comments.



To access your work click on 'My Files'

Once you are in you will see all the work you have created using Just2Easy.

If you have a red speech bubble that means your teacher has commented on your work. Click on the speech bubble.

You will then see the comment and question the teacher has asked to further learning. You can reply to them and they will see them the same way the child does.

Type the message in this box. and press enter to send. Click the microphone to send a voice message or the camera to send a picture.
